Statement for MOSH and MOAH – French AGEC law Art 112

To whom it may concern,

As a part of Epson's commitment to the environment we continuously work on improving the environmental performance of our products. In recent years the focus of our program has, amongst others, been focused on the use of safe chemical substances within our products with a view to contributing to the protection of human health and the environment, including the environmental recovery and disposal of waste.

Article 112 of Law No. 202-105 of 10 February 2020 on the fight against waste for a circular economy inserted in Articles D543-45-1 et seq. of the Environmental Code a ban on the use of mineral oil packaging containing substances that disrupt the recycling of packaging waste or limit the use of the recycled material because of the risks that these substances pose to human health.

The substances concerned by this restriction are listed in the order, of 13 April 2022, published in the Journal Officiel of 3 May 2022

By this letter, Epson confirms that the inks listed in annex 1 do not contain MOSH (Mineral Oil Saturated Hydrocarbons) and MOAH (Mineral Oil Aromatic Hydrocarbons) above the thresholds fixed in the order mentioned above. These inks can be used without restriction on papers and packaging for French market.
