

## Domaine Anne-Françoise Gros/François Parent

Husband and wife team François Parent & Anne-Françoise Gros (cousin of Anne Gros) own cellars just off Place de la Madeleine in Beaune. François is the winemaker and a highly talented one at that. The domaine owns vines in a number of prestigious sites in both the Côte de Beaune and the Côte de Nuits – some inherited from respective sides of their families (essentially François from Pommard and Anne-Françoise from Vosne-Romanée) whereas others have been purchased subsequently. A charming, sophisticated range of 2011's offering much appeal. Their son Mathias has now joined the team - already a wise head on young shoulders.
